Air Force– An increase in laboratory-confirmed Pandemic (H1N1) 2009 cases has been observed among Cadets at the United States Air Force Academy (USAFA) in Colorado Springs, CO. Epidemiologists from the United States Air Force School of Aerospace Medicine (USAFSAM) are working with public health and clinical staff at USAFA to address the situation. USAFSAM is sending a field support Epi team to assist in this effort.
