USAFA Update– The United States Air Force School of Aerospace Medicine (USAFSAM) has sent an epidemiology support team to Colorado Springs, Colorado to assist in the investigation and mitigation campaign at the United States Air Force Academy (USAFSA). USAFSAM has reported a total of 67 positive Pandemic (H1N1) 2009 cases over the past week among new cadets at USAFA.
